2022 LOBSTER FISHERY SEASON IN LOBSTER FISHING AREA 25 (LFA 25)

Moncton, New Brunswick (NB) – August 9, 2021 –The Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO), Gulf Region, wishes to inform industry that the opening date for the lobster fishery in Lobster Fishing Area (LFA) 25 will be Thursday August 11, 2022 at 6:00 a.m. The last day of fishing will be October 12, 2022.

DFO would also like to remind fish harvesters to be careful when navigating on the opening day of the lobster fishery as vessels are loaded with gear and traps. Harvesters are encouraged to be diligent in setting their traps and to ensure that vessels are loaded safely by reducing the amount of gear if necessary.
