PEI COMMERCIAL SILVERSIDE FISHERY

Charlottetown, PE – September 12, 2023 - Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) – Gulf Region wishes to advise the PEI commercial silverside licence holders that the season will open on Sunday, October 1, 2023 and will remain open until Sunday, December 31, 2023.

Gear Markings

As per the Fishery General Regulations (FGRs) section 27, licence holders are required to have silverside nets marked with their name, for identification of fishing gear.

Catch Monitoring

Reminder that there is now a log sheet requirement for all licence holder/operators. The licence holder is required to maintain an up-to-date record of all fishing activities. This log sheet will be attached to all licence holders conditions. The Silverside Logsheet must be presented within fourteen (14) days after the closure of the commercial Silverside fishing season to Fisheries and Oceans Canada, Resource Management, P.O. Box 1236, Charlottetown, PE, C1A 7M8. A nil report must be provided if there was no fishing during the entire fishing season

All other management measures will remain the same for the 2023 season.
