Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) today announces that additional Bluefin Tuna tags will be released.

Canadian Draw numbers from 286 – 319, will be eligible to receive a reallocation tag, once the first fish has been landed. **There will be additional tags released when the Mexican quota becomes available.**

TAG AVAILABILITY: Bluefin Tuna tags and temporary dart tags will be available at the DFO - PEI Area office from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. There will be a maximum of one dart tag to every Bluefin Tuna tag, depending on availability. Temporary dart tags will be free of charge, compliments of, The Prince Edward Island Fishermen's Association.
