The Prince Edward Island Fishermen's Association is pleased to continue as a tag supplier to fishers for the 2016 fishing season.

The PEIFA will continue to supply all species tags, other than tuna, to fishers in LFA's 24, 25 and 26A. This includes those fishers in the above LFA's that are based in Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. Tags will be \$0.40 each plus tax.

Please note, we have included an agreement that requires completion. It is important that you ***order all tags that you will require for the 2016*** fishing seasons, as we are only ordering tags based on the agreements received.

Please complete this form and return in the self-addressed envelope that is included. This will confirm the PEIFA as your tag supplier for 2016. **Deadline for first order is January 13, 2016.**

It is important that you also ***specify how you would like to receive your tags***. If no service option is selected, they will be available at the PEIFA office. **Our service options include:**

1. Tag pick-up in Charlottetown at the PEIFA office.
2. Tag pick-up at one of our scheduled Tag Distribution Days in Western and Eastern PEI. These dates will be advertised.
3. We can mail tags direct to the address of your choice. Payment will be required beforehand and we will call before mailing your order. We use a courier for delivery.

It is a Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) requirement that replacement tags be sourced from the supplier that you purchased your original tags from. We will continue to update harvester and tag information as that information becomes available from the Department of Fisheries and Oceans.

The PEIFA is looking forward to its continued commitment to the fishing community and being your preferred supplier for all your trap and tagging requirements.

The Tags office is open for business and is located in Suite 102 at the Farm Center in Charlottetown. Services will continue to be provided in both official languages.
